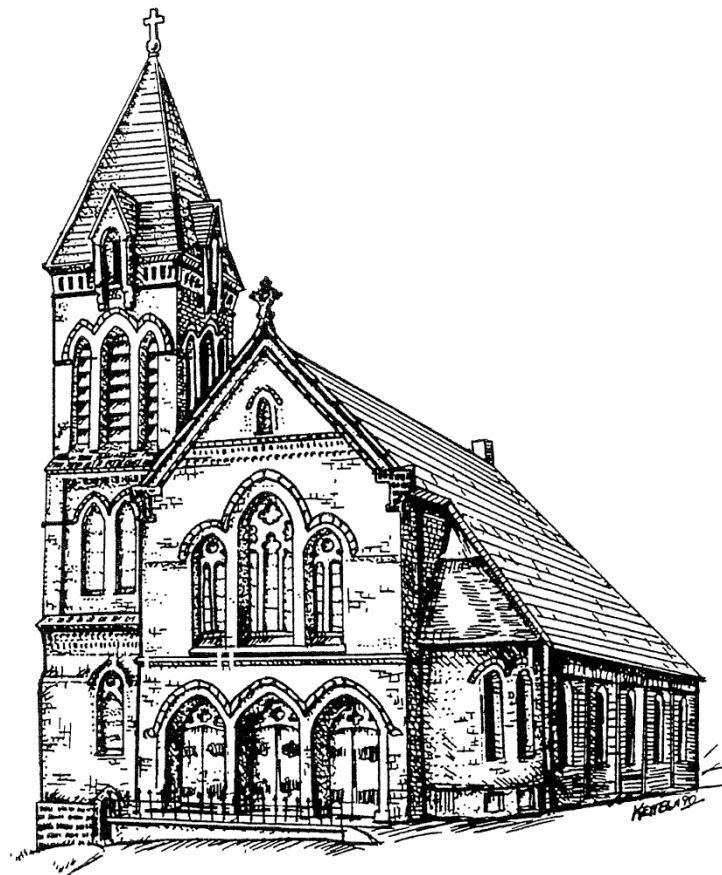
Divine Mercy Sunday Prayer Service - To be held at St. Peter's Church, April 19th at 3pm. Doors open at 2:30pm.
