Religious Education (UPDATED)

We are required to have baptism certificates on file for all Religious Education students (both new and returning) in the fall. If you prefer, you can email us (office@holytrinitysj.com) with the same information. That is all we should need to retrieve your child's baptism information.

Last year some parents had difficulty getting baptism certificates from other parishes. This year, in order to make the process easier, we will try to get the information on your behalf. If your child was baptized in another parish, please contact us with your child's full name, date of birth, approximate date of baptism, names of parents and godparents, and the name of the parish where the baptism took place.

Please also write "**Father's Day**" somewhere on the envelope, so that we can keep the names separate from other memorials that come in.
