New locks will enable us to start fresh and maintain an accurate record of who has a key. We will be contacting those individuals requiring a key to let them know when their replacement is available.

If you normally use that phone to call a taxi after Mass, we suggest booking the taxi to pick you up at a pre-arranged time before coming to Mass.
