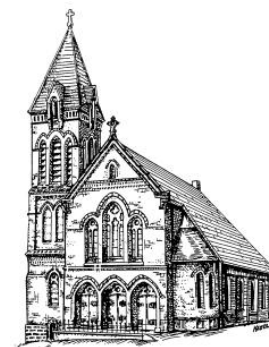

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptismal preparation is required for both parents and godparents and scheduled on a Saturday morning of each month, followed by the baptismal celebration on the following day, Sunday. To make arrangements please call the pastor, Father Stephen at 653-6842.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE / RECONCILIATION

Confessions are celebrated in the church every Saturday from 2:00 pm - 2:30 pm, or at other times if you would like to make an appointment by speaking with Father Peter.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Before the church can be reserved for a wedding and a wedding date finalized, it is necessary to first make an appointment with the pastor to complete the pre-nuptial investigation forms. Couples are requested to give us at least a six month notice and a marriage preparation course is a requirement for all couples who wish to celebrate this Sacrament in the Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT AND MINISTRY TO THE SICK

If there is a family member or relative in the hospital who would like to receive a visit from the pastor, please inform Father Peter.
