Those called to particular roles in parishes and communities need ongoing support and faith development. This program is a two-year journey of faith formation, specifically designed for adult lay women and men, already serving in some aspect of ministry and seeking further spiritual, intellectual and community nurturing and formation.

Whether you are involved in catechetics, liturgy, CWL, Knights of Columbus, parish pastoral council, social committees, outreach, pastoral care or the many other ways in which we build and support our communities, you are invited to consider enrolling in the program to enrich your faith and support your involvement in new and rewarding ways.

Called specifically to be "coresponsible" for the church's life and mission, lay women and men are challenged by the documents of Vatican II and subsequent papal encyclicals to be well-informed in faith, enthusiastic for God's work and capable of leadership in the Church and in society.

The Lay Pastoral Ministry Formation program will begin in September 2011 and include: Scripture, theology, spirituality & prayer, liturgy, church history, leadership development, society & culture, and social justice. The second year of the program will include a practicum, incorporating a service role in parish or community ministry.

Candidates

All committed Catholic adults who show some leadership ability are encouraged to apply. Other important indicators include:

--a spiritually sound faith life --an active role in parish or community ministry

--an ability and willingness to learn

--an ability and affinity for relating with others

--an openness to the teachings of Vatican II

--the support of your parish priest and community

Format

This two-year program will adopt a weekend format. Eight weekends will be held at Villa Madonna Retreat House in Saint John, one weekend in the Miramichi and one in Fredericton. Weekends will begin on Friday evening and conclude shortly after noon on Sunday. These will be live-in experiences, designed to enrich the candidates' personal spiritual growth, enhance knowledge of the Catholic faith and build community. Simultaneously, the candidates will be developing their leadership gifts and pastoral competence for a variety of ministries.
