Father Stephen's Surgery & Recovery

On Friday, June 27th our pastor had surgery to repair the tears in two muscles in his right shoulder. Following the surgery his right arm will be immobilized in a specialized sling for 6 to 8 weeks, which means he will not be able to celebrate Mass. However, Bishop Harris has arranged for another priest to come to our parish and celebrate the Saturday and Sunday Masses every week for us. Unfortunately there will be no weekday Masses until Father Stephen's return — September 1st and maybe not until October 1st, depending on how long it takes him to recover enough use of his right arm to celebrate Mass.

Mass For Those Living With Cancer

Mass will be celebrated on Monday, July 21st, 6:30pm, at the Cathedral, Waterloo Street. Mass will be offered for the intention of people living with cancer and for their families and friends. The Sacrament of Anointing will take place following Mass for those who request it.

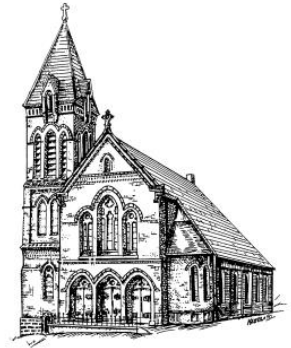

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated on the first Sunday of the month at 1pm for family members of Holy Trinity Parish and those who are living within the geographical boundaries of our parish. To make arrangements for a baptism please contact the office.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE / RECONCILIATION

Confessions are celebrated on Saturdays after the 5:30pm Mass or by appointment. To schedule a time, please speak with Father Peter.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

To reserve our church for a wedding, couples must first make an appointment with our pastor to discuss their plans and complete the pre-nuptial investigation forms. At least a six month notice and taking a marriage preparation course is a requirement. Because of our pastor's schedule for two parishes, weddings cannot be celebrated any later than 1pm on Saturday.

SACRAMENT AND MINISTRY TO THE SICK

If there is a family member or relative in the hospital who would like to receive a visit from the pastor, please inform Father Peter. Also, please let Father Peter know if there is someone sick or confined to their home who would like to receive a visit, receive Holy Communion, or be anointed with the Sacrament of the Sick.
