### Father Stephen's Surgery & Recovery

On Friday, June 27<sup>th</sup> our pastor had surgery to repair the tears in two muscles in his right shoulder. Following the surgery his right arm will be immobilized in a specialized sling for 6 to 8 weeks, which means he will not be able to celebrate Mass. However, Bishop Harris has arranged for another priest to come to our parish and celebrate the Saturday and Sunday Masses every week for us. Unfortunately there will be no weekday Masses until Father Stephen's return — September 1<sup>st</sup> and maybe not until October 1<sup>st</sup>, depending on how long it takes him to recover enough use of his right arm to celebrate Mass.

#### **Diocesan Pastoral Plan - Implementation**

#### THE NEXT STEP IN THE PROCESS

Over the past ten weeks, an overview of our Diocesan Pastoral Plan has been made available. You have been encouraged to access it on line (www.dioceseofsaintjohn.org) and to discuss it with your family and fellow parishioners.

Given that all the baptized are stakeholders in the Church and are co-responsible for the Church's being and action, your being involved in the process is essential as we move ahead.

The question has been asked: "At the local level, how does your faith community look in light of the Priorities for Action ?" Obviously, it is a life-long challenge to embody and reflect the goals which we set for ourselves, goals which surfaced and are the product of a diocesan-wide consultation - the dream of "over a thousand people." (p.10)

In order to implement our Vision (p.16) and our Mission (p.17) it was suggested that every parish needed an active Parish Pastoral Council and that each parish/mission could benefit from a leadership team (p.7) How are these structures which promote communion in the Church being realized in your community?

Our diocesan church, while one local church, is composed of at least three natural regions Fredericton, Miramichi and Saint John. To maximize the sharing of resources and facilitate collaboration, it was suggested that Regional Pastoral Councils should be put in place. We are trusting that this will breathe new life into our diocesan Church.

Here comes the next step in the process.

In September, we will be meeting in the three regions with pastors/administrators and the chair persons of the Parish Pastoral Councils to look at a mechanism to put in place the Regional Pastoral Councils.

Till then, have a good and safe Summer. I encourage you to continue sharing and discussing the Vision, the Mission and the Priorities For Action with family, and fellow parishioners. Please pray for the process we have begun. Thank you for your collaboration.
