Family Centre Kitchen

We have no idea what went down the sink, or when it happened. Given the age of the pipes, the clog may just as likely be an accumulation of build-up over several months. I am asking all groups who use the Family Center to please not put anything down the drains in the kitchen or bathroom sinks other than liquids that have no grease or oil in them. All food scraps should go into the garbage cans, not down the sinks, or the bathroom toilet. If the clogging problem persists, we may have to expose the drain pipes, located behind the tiled bathroom walls, which would be a repair job that would likely cost thousands of dollars, and may make the Family Centre unusable for an extended period of time.
