### 2017 Sunday Envelopes

Envelopes will be available at the back of the church **beginning next weekend**. Following recommendations from parishioners, we have added a monthly **Building Fund** collection for 2017 as well as a monthly **Heating Fund** collection that will only be taken up during heating season.

If the spelling of your name or the address listed on your envelopes is incorrect, please contact the office, as that is the address where your 2016 tax receipts will be sent in January. If you would like Envelopes, boxes for new parishioners will also be available.

### Memorial Tree

Many have found our Memorial Tree to be a helpful way of remembering and dealing with feelings of loss during an otherwise happy time. If this is helpful for you, you are invited to print the names(s) of deceased relatives and friends on the outside of an envelope and mark it "Memorial Tree". These names will be placed on ornaments prepared and decorated by the children in our Religious Education Program and the ornaments will be placed on the Tree. While you may also use the same envelope to make a voluntary donation to our Building Fund, a donation is not required. Deadline for submission of names is **Sunday, December 11<sup>th</sup>**.

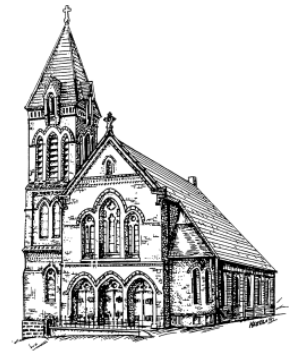
