Breakfast

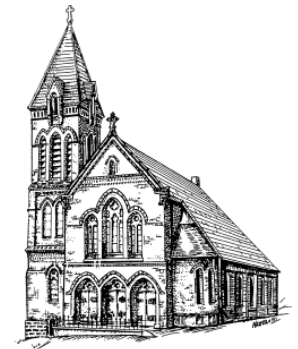
