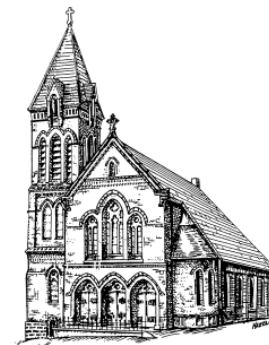

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

To be married at Holy Trinity church, couples must first make an appointment with Father Peter to discuss their plans and complete the pre-nuptial investigation forms. At least a six month notice and taking a marriage preparation course is a requirement.
