Dear Sisters and Brothers:

Once again I will be present at the **March for Life** on Thursday, May 19, 2016. I invite you to be there with me and hundreds of women and men who gather from all over New Brunswick.

The theme of this year's **March for Life** is *The Truth That Endures: The Sanctity of All Human Life*. Here is the schedule of events:

10:00 am	I will preside a con-celebrated Mass in St. Dunstan's Church.
11:30 am - 1:00 pm	We will gather in front of the New Brunswick Provincial Legislature. Several speakers will address the gathering including our former Lt. Governor Graydon Nicholas.
1:00 pm - 1:30 pm	The <b>March for Life</b> will walk through the streets of downtown Fredericton.

At a time when life continues to be threatened in so many ways, we continue to affirm without hesitation and with great conviction that human life is sacred. The teachings of our faith affirm that "every person from conception to natural death, in whatever state or condition they are found, has an inalienable right to life" (CCC 2273). As Catholic Christians, we cannot support abortion nor euthanasia nor assisted suicide.

Your presence at the **March for Life** will speak loudly about your objection to Bill C-14, the proposed new law which threatens both life and the freedom of conscience.

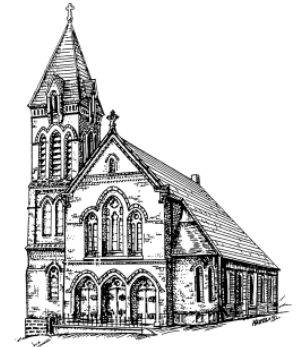
