The Lily Lake Pavilion is hosting a free movie every Tuesday night beginning at dusk. Movies will be shown inside the Pavilion during inclement weather.

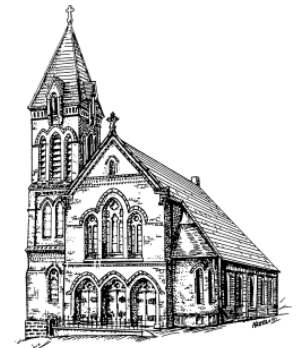
