Country Jam Session

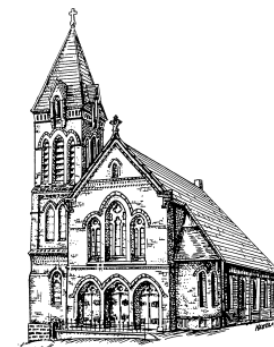
