The Catholic Bookstore

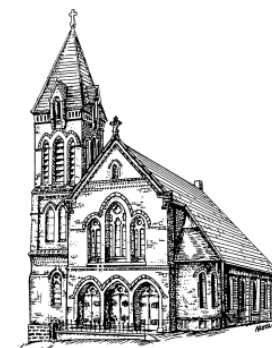
