### Lenten Stations of the Cross

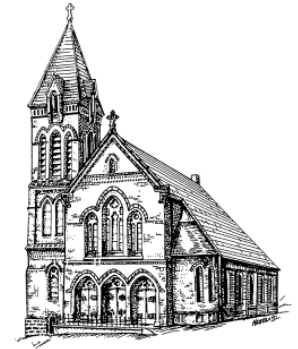
A celebration of the Way of the Cross will take place in the church every Friday at 5pm during the Season of Lent.
