Card Party

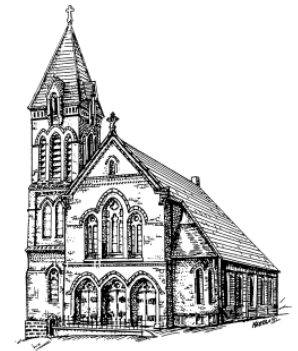
