Card Party

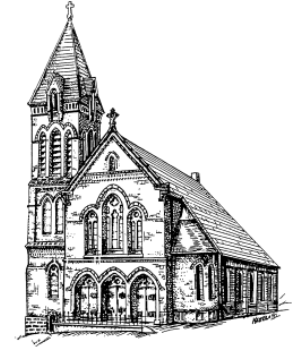
Holy Trinity hosts an Auction 45s Card Party every Monday beginning at 1 pm in the Family Center. Light refreshments will be served. Admission is \$3.
