Concert

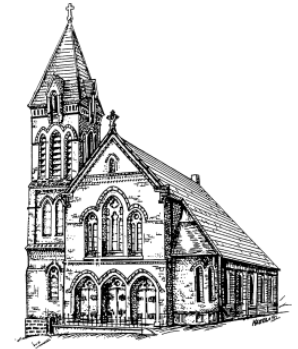
